

We'll visit the Dobson Museum, a fascinating collection of artifacts highlighting the history of Ottawa County life, mining, military, Native American culture, famous residents, and industry.

After touring the Route 66 Vintage Iron Motorcycle Museum, which is home to the Evel Knievel collection and features more than 25 vintage motorcycles, we'll jaunt a few miles to Commerce, OK and visit Micky Mantle's boyhood home.





Level 3 have some longer and shorter days and some leisure time. Walking longer distances over uneven terrain, and climbing stairs should be expected.



To enjoy level 4 tours, you should be able to walk longer distances over uneven terrain, climb stairs and stand for a time. Some activities may occur in the evening.
