#### **December 3, 2021 - Your Journey Begins!**

Today, you'll board your international flight to the **Netherlands!**

#### **December 4, 2021 - Board the AmaSerena in Amsterdam!**

This morning, you'll arrive in **Amsterdam** and transfer to board the lovely **AmaSerena**. This 156 passenger river boat is filled with all the amenities you've come to expect, from complimentary internet access and first-run Hollywood movies to beautifully-decorated accommodations. After unpacking for your 7 nights cruising the Rhine, enjoy your **Welcome Dinner!** You may also take advantage of your free evening to go out and discover this great city as the ship moors here overnight. You might **sample delicious local specialties** at one of Amsterdam's grand cafés, or simply go exploring on your own, perhaps to shop the unique **Christmas Markets** or simply stroll the legendary canal-lined streets. #### **December 5, 2021 - Amsterdam's Canals and Sail Away!**

Today you'll embark on your **Amsterdam canal tour** through some of the city's 165 canals past beautiful bridges, churches and centuries-old merchant houses. Later in the day, enjoy a **scenic sail away** from Amsterdam to begin your **cruise of the Romantic Rhine!** (B/L/D)

#### **December 6, 2021 - Cologne's Mighty Cathedral!**

This morning you'll cruise to **Cologne, Germany** for the day. Enjoy a walking tour through the narrow streets of the Old Town on your way to **Cologne Cathedral**, the city's most beloved landmark. Beneath the Cathedral and the **largest Christmas tree in the Rhineland**, you'll find over 160 festively designed wooden pavilions where you can watch artisans at work, enjoy mulled wine from jolly Christmas mugs or choose from a wide array of sweets and local delicacies! Or instead you might decide to visit a colorful local tavern and savor Cologne's traditional **Kölsch beer and Reibekuchen** - potato pancakes served with apple sauce. Cologne boasts no less than **five Christmas Markets** that you can discover at your own pace following your tour. (B/L/D)

#### **December 7, 2021 - Cruise the Romantic Rhine River Valley!**

This morning your ship sails the **Romantic Rhine Valley**, so be ready to relax and enjoy the **magical views!** With precipitous cliffs, steep vineyards, a castle perched on virtually every hilltop and charming

villages lining the river banks, **the Middle Rhine is straight out of a picture-book!** This afternoon at the winemaking town of **Rüdesheim** you can visit **Siegfried's Mechanical Instrument Museum's** collection of robotic and self-playing musical instruments or take a gondola ride to the **Niederwalddenkmal Statue** with its panoramic views of the river. Afterward, indulge in a sampling of Riesling wines in the vineyards, then visit the town's massive **Christmas Market**, with more than 120 stands of delicacies and unique gifts guaranteed to put you in a festive mood. You might also sample the town's specialty, **Rüdesheimer Coffee**, laced with brandy and whipped cream. (B/L/D)

#### **December 8, 2021 - Historical Towns of Germany!**

Today from Ludwigshafen, you may embark on an **excursion to Heidelberg**, where you'll visit the **mighty red-walled Castle** and its Great Vat, a 49,000-gallon 18th-century wine cask, and enjoy sweeping views of the Neckar Valley and Heidelberg below. You'll have time to wander the **Hauptstrasse**, said to be the longest pedestrian shopping street in Germany, soaking up the Yuletide celebrations at the town's Christmas Markets. Or instead you might take a **tour of medieval Speyer**, one of Germany's oldest cities known for its Cathedral, churches, and the **Altpörtel** - a 13th-century gate tower. The **Speyer Christmas Market** features not only German made goods, but unique products from Speyer's eight sister cities! (B/L/D)

#### **December 9, 2021 - Christmas Markets in France!**

This morning, the AmaSerena cruises to the picturesque **capital of the Alsace region** in northeast France, **Strasbourg**, known for its black and white timber-framed buildings, covered bridges and medieval watchtowers. Here you may take a **walking tour** along the narrow cobbled streets to see the European Parliament and visit the "**La Petite France**" district, with its sandstone Gothic cathedral and famed astronomical clock. In the afternoon, visit **Gengenbach Christmas Market** where every year the locals count down to Christmas with their 24-day, **larger-than-life Advent calendar!** The rest of the day is yours to shop, explore or visit the **Christkindelsmärik, France's oldest Christmas Market**, dating back to 1570. (B/L/D)

#### **December 10, 2021 - Basel and Lucerne, Switzerland!**

It's a true joy getting to know **Switzerland's third largest city** - for many centuries an important university, banking and trade center,

Basel's glorious past is still evident in its **medieval town hall, richly decorated market square** and **exquisite 18th-century patrician homes**. Later in the day, you'll venture out to visit lovely **Lucerne**, known for its **Lion Monument** – the figure of a dying lion carved into a hillside in memory of the Swiss Guards massacred during the French Revolution in 1792 – which **Mark Twain** described as “the most mournful and moving piece of stone in the world.” You'll also see **Lucerne's spectacular medieval walls and towers**, dating back to the 13th century. You'll surely become entranced by this charming city perched at the base of the **Swiss Alps!** (B/L/D)

**December 11, 2021 - It's Off to Zurich, Switzerland!**

This morning after breakfast, you'll disembark from the ship in Basel and make your way across the **scenic Swiss countryside** with its towering snow-capped peaks and Alpine lakes, on the way to Switzerland's largest city, **Zurich**, where you'll enjoy a panoramic sightseeing tour. See the city's numerous highlights along the shores of **Lake Zurich**, including the famous **“Bahnhofstrasse”** shopping district where exclusivity, quality and variety meet. Later this afternoon, you'll check in to your hotel and then enjoy a special **Swiss fondue farewell dinner!**
