

Day 1: Friday, July 24, 2020 Overnight



Visit a local wine cooperative, where a tour of the cellars demands a tasting of their everlasting vintages and a chance to learn how nature, soil and tradition converge to create a vintage's character and flavor. Day 4: Monday, July 27, 2020

Neuchâtel Enjoy a day of leisure in Neuchâtel. You may use your Swiss Travel Pass to explore the surrounding areas or just relax and stroll this charming place. Perhaps you will choose an optional e-biking excursion on Switzerland's Absinthe Trail to Maison de l'Absinthe to learn the history of production and enjoy a private tasting and cooking experience. (B)

Day 5: Tuesday, July 28, 2020

Neuchâtel - Bern - Zermatt From Neuchâtel, travel via train to Bern, the Swiss capital city. Enjoy time at leisure to discover Bern's enthralling blend of influences - old and new.

Then it's on to the striking resort village of Zermatt nestled against the backdrop of the Matterhorn. (B, D)

Day 6: Wednesday, July 29, 2020

Zermatt Zermatt's modern holiday amenities steeped in traditional Alpine roots make this pedestrian city a truly peak experience. Today is yours to explore all this village has to offer. Consider using your Swiss Travel Pass to ascend the Gornergrat Railway to take in breathtaking views of the famed Matterhorn. (B)

Day 7: Thursday, July 30, 2020

Zermatt - Vevey Say goodbye to Zermatt and head to the north shore of Lake Geneva to Vevey, one of the "Pearls of the Swiss Riviera," with awe-inspiring views of the Alpine panorama. While the city's promenades and majestic hotels are classic reminders of the *Belle Époque*, its modernity is characterized by its art and music festivals, and the ever-present memory of Charlie Chaplin, who spent the last quarter of his life as a resident. Enjoy a walking tour before paying a visit to Läderach. Switzerland is world-famous for its chocolate, and Läderach chocolate is



Swiss perfection. Participate in an immersive tasting workshop that reveals a behind-the-scenes glimpse at the artistry behind the handmade Swiss chocolate. (B)

Day 8: Friday, July 31, 2020 Vevey - Lavaux - Vevey A relaxed morning in Vevey preludes your journey to the terraced vineyards of Lavaux. Begin with lunch at a family-owned restaurant before visiting with our friends, Jacques and Aurelia, for a wine tasting nestled amongst the vines. Traipse the Lavaux vineyards (UNESCO) on foot before enjoying another tasting of the region's finest varieties. (B, L)

Day 9: Saturday, August 1, 2020 Vevey Today, **it's your choice!** Enjoy a full day of leisure in Vevey. Take advantage of your Swiss Travel Pass and discover the city's museums,

including the Swiss Camera Museum, Charlie Chaplin Museum, and the Nestle Foundation's Nest -**OR-** discover Montreux and Château de Chillon, then travel back to Vevey on Lake Geneva. Gather in the evening for a farewell dinner at one of Vevey's best local restaurants. (B, D)

Biking the Absinthe Trail

\$120 USD

Embark on a rail journey to the village of Noiraigue at the eastern end of the Val de Travers. Pedal the banks of the Areuse River on a leisurely and illuminating bicycle tour, where the impressive torrents and bridged ravines of the Areuse deliver you to Motiers, the oldest village in the Val de Tavers. The cultural center of the region, Motiers bears a rich history that's steeped in art, heritage, and the production of the "green fairy" – known otherwise as absinthe. A visit to the Maison de l'Absinthe introduces you to the eventful history behind the region's production of absinthe, while a stroll through the grounds of the museum yields the sight of some 1,200-strong plants and herbs – absinthe's loyal ingredients. Enjoy a tasting of 2 absinthe varietals, and bring out the kid in you during a make-your-own absinthe ice cream workshop. *Duration: Approximately 6 hours.* Please note a minimum of 10 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Zermatt

Hiking the Swiss Alps

Embrace a one-of-a-kind adventure on a hike through the very heart of the Swiss Alps. Breathe in the pure Alpine air while surrounded by one of the most brilliant mountain panoramas in the world, where the Matterhorn reigns dominative. Ascend more than 10,000 feet on board Europe's highest mountain railway, through tunnels and over snow-capped peaks to Gornergrat Mountain. Step off at Rotenboden, where the Matterhorn reflects against the surface of the lake, and Italy's mountains tower in the distance. Set out on a leisurely hike over breathtaking terrain in the company of your mountain guide, who points out the varieties of flora and fauna that inhabit the mountain landscape. *Duration: Approximately 6 hours.* Please note a minimum of 10 passengers is required. Transportation is included.
