

DAY 1 Depart the USA: Depart the USA on your overnight flight to Dubrovnik, Croatia.

DAY 2 Dubrovnik, Croatia: Welcome to Dubrovnik, commonly known as “the Pearl of the Adriatic”! Upon arrival, you’ll be met by a representative of Mayflower Cruises & Tours and transferred to your private yacht, and home for the next seven nights. Relax onboard as you become acquainted with the ship and the crew. This evening enjoy a Welcome Reception and dinner onboard as the yacht remains in port overnight. **Meal: D**

DAY 3 Dubrovnik – Slano: After breakfast, depart on your tour of Dubrovnik with a local guide. Discover the charms of Dubrovnik’s Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, stroll along its white limestone streets and see baroque buildings and its ancient city walls that protected a civilized, sophisticated republic for centuries. After the tour, return to the yacht and set sail for Slano, reaching the Pelješac Peninsula’s wine empire. Enjoy an included tour of Ston, a jewel of the Adriatic Coast. Following the tour, a wine-tasting session completes today’s adventure. **Meals: B, L, D**

DAY 4 Slano – Mljet – Korčula: Begin today’s journey with a stop in Mljet, one of the most forested islands of the Adriatic. You will have free time to enjoy the pristine beauty of the island’s untouched nature, mystic groves and vineyards. If you choose, join the DiscoverMORE guided tour. Next, visit the island of Korčula, one of the greenest islands in the Adriatic Sea. Like most of the Croatian islands, the Greeks, who gave it the name Korkyra Melaina or “Black Corfu” for its dark, densely wooded appearance, first settled Korčula. Explore the town on a guided tour, passing its typical medieval architecture, including towers and clusters of red-roofed houses. Marco Polo, the famous world-traveler and writer, as well as a Venetian merchant, is reputed to have been born here. **Meals: B, L**

DiscoverMORE: Guided tour of Mljet National Park (additional expense)

DAY 5 Korčula – Hvar: Relax onboard as the yacht sails to Hvar. With its beautiful fields of lavender and carefully cultivated vineyards, the island is considered one of the most beautiful in the world. Carpeting the hillsides around its cozy harbor are terracotta roofed villas, Gothic palaces and 13th-century ramparts rising towards an impressive citadel. During your included guided tour, visit the impressive bell towers of the Franciscan Monastery, St. Mark’s Church and the Cathedral of St. Stephen. **Meals: B, L**

DAY 6 Hvar – Pucišća – Split: Your exploration continues with a visit to the coastal town of Pucišća on the island of Brač, known for its white limestone, most notably that which was used to build part of the White House in Washington DC. For many generations, locals have been making use of the stone and during the included walking tour, you’ll visit a stone mason school. Founded in 1909, the school provides educational support for local students, producing quality religious icons, fountains and statues. After the tour, return to the yacht for an afternoon of sailing towards Split, the second largest city in Croatia and the largest city on the Adriatic Coast. Stroll with your guide on a walking tour viewing the city’s fantastic sites, including the seafront promenade, and the Roman Emperor Diocletian’s Palace with its ancient columns and Roman belfries. **Meals: B, L**

EmeraldPLUS: Tour of Pucišća & visit to a stone masonry school

DAY 7 Šibenik: Your day begins with a guided walking tour of Šibenik, one of the oldest towns on the Adriatic Coast. This charming town boasts fantastic monuments dating back to Venetian times, particularly the marble Cathedral of St. James – a UNESCO World Heritage site. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure to continue exploring this beautiful town on your own. **Meals: B, L**

DAY 8 Šibenik – Trogir: Today’s adventure takes you to Krka National Park, named after the Krka River. Magnificent waterfalls are a top attraction of the park, including the famous Skradinski Buk Falls - one of Croatia’s most famous sights. A local guide will

provide a tour of the park, and you can even swim in some areas, so be sure to pack your swimwear! Later, cruise to the town of Trogir, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The small, historic center of this medieval town resembles an outdoor museum, and the streets boast magnificent Romanesque churches and beautiful examples of Renaissance and Baroque architecture. **Meals: B, L**

DAY 9 Trogir - Plitvice Lakes: After breakfast it is time to bid farewell to your boutique yacht, captain and crew and travel by motorcoach to another UNESCO World Heritage Site, Plitvice Lakes, where breathtaking scenery awaits. Have your camera ready as you take a walking tour around several of the lower lakes at Plitvice Lakes National Park. The scenery of this natural wonder is spectacular, with 16-terraced lakes surrounded by thickly wooded mountains and lush vegetation. Check in to your hotel and enjoy dinner. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 10 Plitvice Lakes – Zagreb – Ljubljana, Slovenia: Journey to Zagreb, Croatia’s capital and largest city. Enjoy a city tour featuring the delightful, historic Upper Town, with its network of little streets that stretch between Kaptol and Gradec Hills. It’s the oldest part of the city! Visit St. Mark’s Church, St. Catherine’s Church, the Cathedral, the Parliament and Government Palace. Continue on to Ljubljana, the largest city and capital of Slovenia. With exquisite architecture, a river dividing the historic old town from the modern city center, a 900-year-old castle perched atop a hill and friendly locals, this town is sure to please. **Meal: B**

DAY 11 Ljubljana – Postojna: On your morning walking tour see the most significant sights of the old city center of Ljubljana, including the picturesque, open-air Central Market, the Three Bridges, Baroque Town Hall and Robba’s Fountain. After some free time, journey by motorcoach north to Postojna, home to one of the largest caves in Europe. Tour this fantastic subterranean world by miniature electric train, followed by a walking tour of the caves. Next, you’ll stop at Predjama Castle for a photo opportunity. Return to Ljubljana and end your day with an included dinner. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 12 Ljubljana – Vienna, Austria: After breakfast depart by coach to Vienna, Austria. En route enjoy a stop in Bled, Slovenia, a lively all-season resort town which was first discovered by travelers in the middle of the 19th century. Since then it has developed into a small town of hotels, villas and restaurants around the lake. During an included tour, walk along the lake and visit Bled Castle. Afterwards enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Once in Vienna participate in a brief walking tour of the city center, passing the Hofburg Palace and strolling through the surrounding area. Enjoy a farewell dinner with your fellow travelers this evening.

Meals: B, L, D

DAY 13 Vienna / USA: Bid a fond farewell to the Dalmatian Coast, Croatia, Slovenia and Austria as you transfer to the airport and return home with memories of life enriching experiences from your small ship adventure. **Meal: B**




UPPER DECK
